Certificate Overview

The graduate certificate in Executive Communication Skills is designed to give students a broad communication background critical to leadership success within organizations. The emphasis focuses on building expertise in verbal as well as non-verbal forms of communication while preparing professionals to communicate effectively to groups inside and outside of the organization. This certificate is offered on the graduate level and may be completed in conjunction with the Master of Arts in Professional Development and the Master of Science in Human Relations & Business.
