

Second Degree Plans for Professional Counseling and Marriage & Family Therapy Counseling Programs

MA Professional Counseling and MA Marriage & Family Therapy Counseling degrees require 60 total credit hours to complete each degree. Students desiring a second degree in either one of these programs must complete all degree requirements for the second degree; however, under no circumstances will an official second degree plan be less than an additional 12 credit hours, regardless of the second degree requirements. <u>NOTE</u>: Amberton recommends that students complete the MA Professional Counseling first.
