Indicator Definition and How it was Calculated:

Persistence is defined by percent of new students who enrolled in at least one of the next two sessions after their initial enrollment in the 2021 calendar year. **Retention** is defined by percent of new students who enrolled in the next calendar year after their initial enrollment.

Graduation rate is defined by the number of 2013/2014 new students who completed their degree (BBA/PM or MBA/PM) with Amberton within 8 years.
