FAFSA Information Required to be Verified	Required Documentation
Identity Options include: in person, via zoom, or a compliant third party entity.	The student should appear in person at the school and present an unexpired, valid, government-issued photo identification (such as a passport or a driver's license). If the student is unable to appear in person, the student has the option of appearing on a video call to present an unexpired, valid, government-issued photo identification (such as a passport or a driver's license) to an institutionally authorized individual who will review and take a screenshot of the identification. The student will then be required to submit (via email) a copy of the identification presented. Alternatively, the Department will consider a student's identity to be verified if the student's identity was verified by an entity that is compliant with National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Identity Assurance Level 2 (NIST IAL2). Note: An ID issued by a state university or college is not sufficient for this purpose.
