The Graduate Certificate in Finance is ideal for Amberton students who desire to enhance their finance toolkit, gain skills in a high-demand field, and analyze information to derive meaningful and actionable insights. The curriculum focuses on the fundamental concepts of corporate, managerial, and international finance, as well as developing expertise in understanding and preparing financial statements.
