### Certificate Overview

The certificate in Project Management is a 4-course certificate program that provides high-level training in the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK). Established by the Project Management Institute (PMI), the PMBOK is a set of standards that dictate which skills and knowledge a project management professional should have. The PMBOK outlines vital best practices, guidelines, professional terminology, and accepted practices that project managers can use to achieve effective leadership results. While every project manager has a slightly different leadership style—and is encouraged to develop his or her leadership strategy and methodology by tailoring the PMBOK to suit the project at hand—successful project managers should certainly have a detailed understanding of these standards.
