## Certificate Overview

The certificate in Project Management offers students a comprehensive review of project management concepts and techniques from an introductory level. After the successful completion of the four courses, students will not only have mastered competencies required for project management within organizations but will also have completed 12 hours of college credit toward a degree. This certificate may be completed online and in conjunction with the University's seven undergraduate degrees.
