The Graduate Certificate in Strategic Leadership is ideal for Amberton students seeking to enhance their leadership capabilities in organizational environments. The curriculum focuses on the foundational principles of strategic leadership, emphasizing the development of skills necessary for leading programs and initiatives effectively. It provides students with the foundational skills required to succeed in the leadership field, including servant leadership principles that prioritize empowering teams and fostering a collaborative environment, and executive leadership competencies that prepare students for high-level decision-making roles.
