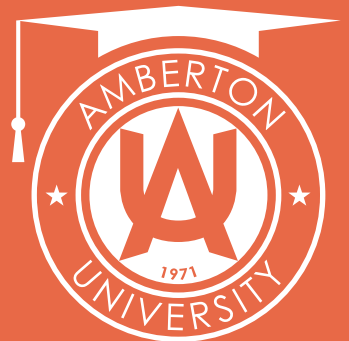

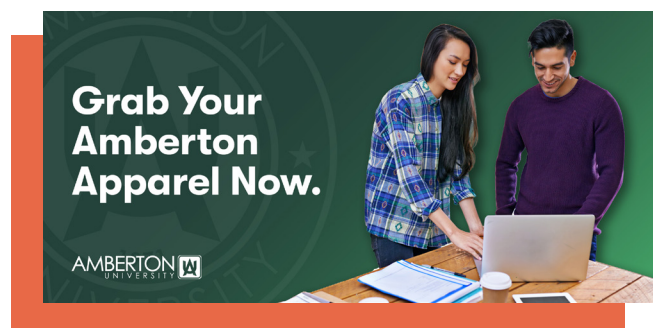

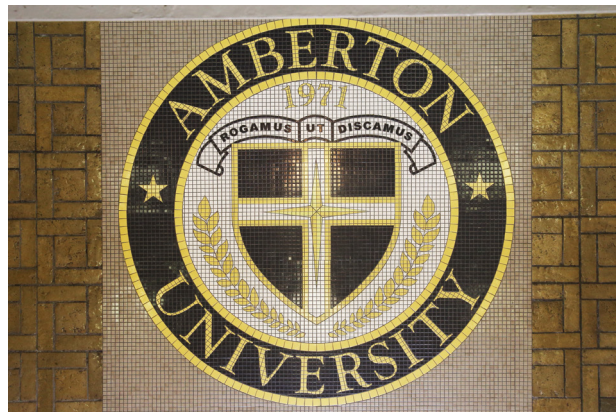

Leading with Purpose: Investing in Education, Faith, and Growth

As General Manager of Food & Nutrition Services with Aramark at Baylor University Medical Center, Aubla Clay advanced her leadership journey through Amberton University, supported by faith, flexibility, and a drive to develop others.

Growing up, my father would always say, “Get your education because that’s something no one can take from you.” That message stayed with me as I advanced in my career and stepped into my role as General Manager of Food & Nutrition Services with Aramark at Baylor University Medical Center. With increased responsibility, I knew I needed to grow as a leader and invest in myself.

That decision led me to Amberton University, where I pursued a degree in Human Resource Training and

Development while balancing the demands of leading a large team. Amberton’s flexible payment plans and affordable structure made it accessible, and with \$5,500 a year in education assistance from my company, I was able to complete my degree without financial strain. My faith is very important to me, and Amberton’s mission, rooted in Christian faith and biblical principles, made it feel like the right place from the very beginning.

During my final year, I experienced the loss of my oldest sister, and the compassion and support I received from my instructors reflected Colossians 3:12, “Clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience,” confirming that I was exactly where I needed to be.

I graduated in May 2022, carrying both a sense of accomplishment and a deeper appreciation for the journey and a renewed sense of purpose to lead, develop others, and continue growing.
